APPLICATION FOR PARTICIPATION

To take part in the **Computer Science-2025**, the prospective authors are invited to submit papers on the above listed topics. Each author can participate in at most three papers. Each paper should be submitted via the conference management system. The papers must be formatted according to the templates and submitted by the deadline.

PARTICIPATION FEES

The registration fee is 180 EUR for participation in an electronic environment and 360 EUR for participants present on site. It includes admission to Conference sessions and a Copy of Conference Proceedings. There will be reduced fees for students and for members of IEEE (15%). Early registration fees are 150 EUR and 300 EUR, respectively.

REVIEWING, PARTICIPATION AND PUBLISHING

The paper should be submitted together with the author's information including full mailing address and e-mail address. Each paper will be reviewed by two reviewers. The full papers will be reviewed and checked for plagiarism by IEEE CrossCheck / iThenticate. If the submitted paper does not meet the IEEE requirements, the authors will receive the result of the review and will be able to make changes within 5 days. In case of a significant match rate (over 50%), manuscripts will be rejected.

Notification of the acceptance of the contribution will be given after **July 15, 2025**.

A full paper proposal in .doc and .pdf formats have to be packed together in one ZIP file and electronically submitted through the COMPUTER SCIENCE 2025 Conference Management System no later than the deadline (**1 October 2025**).
